# Exhibition CITY RENEWAL LVIV 2017

## Urban design proposals for the Central Train Station Area and the Military Unit Site at Shevchenka Street.

Two brownfield areas close to the city center of Lviv were considered appropriate for densification and to undergo an urban transformation process based on sustainability and the preservation of resources. The area around the Central Railway Station (fourteen ha) and the Military Unit Site on Shevchenka Street (nine ha) were subject to the development of academic proposals of urban design within an international academic cooperation project.

Seventy architecture students and fourteen tutors from five universities in the Ukraine, Austria and Poland worked together with the Lviv Municipal Administration on this project during the summer term of the academic year in 2017.

A so called **Urban Density Lab Lviv 2017** was organized within the framework of the academic partnership between Vienna University of Technology and Lviv Polytechnic University. Three additional universities from the Ukraine and Poland joined this working process.

The outcome of this international academic cooperation activities were eleven urban design proposals for the Central Railway Station area and ten proposals for the Military Unit Site.



The aim of the exhibition ***City Renewal Lviv 2017***, presented from September the 14<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> at the Lviv Town Hall, was to present the most valuable project results to the public. The following criteria were used by the curators to select the 15 presented projects:

- a clear conceptual positioning within the international and local landscape to strengthen the identity of the inhabitants
- spatial and functional quality of the urban design solutions
- the interconnection to the surrounding urban environment and to central urban hot spots in Lviv
- the quality of the future-based urban habitat in co-existence with cultural heritage.
